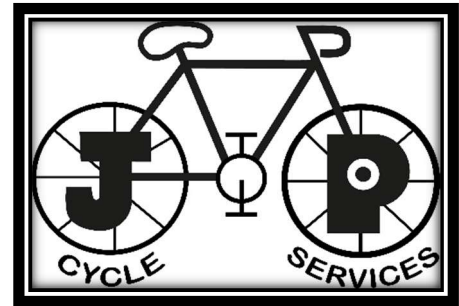

The following items are MANDATORY for attending this session:

- Roadworthy bike with working front and rear brakes
- Correctly fitting bicycle helmet
- Suitable clothing and footwear, including waterproofs if it's raining
- A drink and a snack

The following items are OPTIONAL for attending this session:

- Cycling Gloves

Session Details:

- The session is run from Langford Village Primary School playground. The meeting point is at the staff car park, Langford Village Primary School, Peregrine Way, Bicester OX26 6SX.
- The session is suitable for children aged 7 to 12.
- A responsible adult is required to stay nearby for the duration of the session to meet safeguarding requirements.
- There are no toilet facilities available on site.

Terms and Conditions:

In order to take part in this training the following terms and conditions must be agreed to:

- The child's bike must be roadworthy. Minor adjustments to the bike can be made at the start of the session by the instructor, however a non-roadworthy bike will not be accepted on the course and your child's place is non-refundable or transferrable. If you're not sure, contact us in advance.
- The instructor has the right to withhold training at any point if they deem the behaviour or competence level of the trainee to be unsuitable.
- Elements of this session may use ramps, kickers, rollers, limbo poles or skinny sets. All equipment used will be risk assessed.
- If the weather is extreme on the day, the session will be cancelled around 1 hour before it is due to start and the session will be rearranged. Each attendee will be contacted in the event of a cancellation. The session will continue in light rain or showers.
- JP Cycle Services is not liable for any injury, loss or damage to person's property during, before or after the training.
- It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide a well fitted helmet. If the trainee sustains injuries through lack of an appropriate helmet, JP Cycle Services accepts no responsibility for this.
